This nomination introduces an opportunity for consideration towards one of five scholarships awarded by the Officials Hall of Fame Committee, as well as an invitation for you and your student to attend the annual awards banquet.

2019 marks the 38th annual year this program and award(s) have been in place. This longstanding tradition has become a staple in the fall for the 27 Snohomish County High Schools, including South Whidbey. Over the past 37 years the Snohomish County Football Officials Hall of Fame Committee has presented numerous scholarships to many deserving recipients. Each nominee is required to submit a Nomination Packet. The contents of this packet include the Scholar Athlete's Nomination Form and their Areas of Achievement Package. The details of this package are highlighted on the bottom of the Nomination Form. Included in the Areas of Achievement Package for scholastic accomplishments, **must be** an unopened and certified High School Transcript. The nominee should focus on outlining contributions to community, school, academics, family, and gained awards throughout their High School career.

Nomination Packets must be submitted by **Wednesday November 13, 2019**.

This year's Scholar Athlete banquet will be held on Wednesday, December 4th at the Rose Hill Community Center in Mukilteo. The event will kick-off at **6:00 pm** and invited guests are encouraged to show up between 5:30 and 6:00 pm. As a part of this award and special evening, the nominee and two (2) additional meals are being provided by a community sponsor. Additional tickets may be purchased for \$50 each, and must be reserved in advance. You may reserve additional tickets by contacting HOF@scfoa.org. This is a formal evening, and appropriate attire is **expected**. Each nominee is guaranteed a plaque commemorating their consideration for this scholarship.
